COLLABORATIVE HOUSING RESEARCH

The Co-Lab Research group works on the development and valorisation of knowledge on collaborative ways of producing and managing living environments. It focuses on understanding the current re-emergence of "collaborative housing" forms in The Netherlands and abroad, such as cohousing, resident-led housing co-operatives, Community Land Trusts and others. The group was established in early 2018 by Dr. Darinka Czischke at the Department of Management in the Built Environment at the Faculty of Architecture and the Built Environment at the TU Delft. Ever since, the group has grown to include one post-doctoral researcher, one research assistant, three PhD researchers and six masters' graduation students. During the first year of its existence, Co-Lab Research members have carried out the NWO-funded project "Samen Wonen, Samen Onderzoeken", published scientific papers, given a number of media interviews, and presented their research at several conferences and seminars.


